



## Download & Upload New Report Definition


- Download report definition files & upload to any instance

## Export to PowerPoint – Reports & Dashboards


- Any report or dashboard

- Each dashboard report exported to its own slide






## List Report Container Title Font Options

Container title typeface and font options for List: Basic, List: Stacked, List: Time Series, & Gantt reports









# Pie & Donut Charts Available for Time Series Specialty

Pie and Donut report types added for Time Series specialty reports



#### Calculated Field Entity: Timesheet Entry




- Timesheet Entry moved from Reporting Entity to Standard Entity
