
- Recognize the need to adjust and adapt to the direction


PMO and Business Agility

The technology and markets are moving faster, whereas culture and processes take time to evolve

The need for greater business agility is driving a fundamental shift in the role of the PMO globally

88% of the businesses believe that the capability to respond more quickly to opportunities should give them a distinct advantage

Majority of companies believe the PMO should be supporting business and IT Strategy development and execution, but only 30% actually doing it




Empower the PMOs to challenge the status quo and be the leader to drive the change

Freedom with Fences


- Adopted a new vision to meet business demand of 200,000 motorcycles per year


