#### **Fixed issues**

Product area	Request number	Description
Billing	CPC-2023-00132	Internal server error 500 occurs during loading of a committed invoice profile page for a contract for which the billing type was changed from hourly to daily, and which is set to use daily conversion rates from the billing office.
Budgeting	CPC-2023-00098	Task assignment effort that occurs outside of the planned start and planned finish dates is not copied to the budget service.
Project Worksheet	CPC-2022-00593	Column filter does not work for Boolean columns (for example, Billable, Milestone, Capital) in Project Worksheet.
Project Management	CPC-2023-00073	Actual hours in tasks and task assignments do not match.
Project Management	CPC-2023-00085	The "From" address of email notifications for project schedule changes was hard-coded to use the current user's email address instead of the From Address that was configured in Changepoint Mail Service.
Revenue Recognition	CPE-2023-00055	Revenue recognition method can be changed for committed fixed fee revenue.

#### Installing the release package using the installer

1. Copy the contents of the setup folder to a location on the web server or database server.

**Note:** If the web server and database server are on different physical servers, you must install the release package on both servers.

2. Run \Setup\Setup.exe using **Administrator** rights, then follow the prompts.

**Important:** Be sure to select all the features that are applicable for the target server in the **Select Features** screen.

#### Installing the release package manually

You can use the following instructions to upgrade the Changepoint instances manually instead of using the installer.

# **Upgrading the Changepoint database**

- 1. Copy the files from the \Manual Upgrade\Database\ folder to a writeable folder on the Changepoint database server.
- 2. Remove the read-only attribute on the copied files.
- 3. Run the SQL import utility: SQLImport.exe. The **Changepoint SQL Update Utility** dialog box appears.
- 4. Complete the following fields:
  - a) In the MigrationDII folder, select
     Changepoint.DatabaseServices.DBMigrations.dll, and then click Open.
  - b) In the **SQL Server** field, enter the name of the SQL server.
  - c) In the **Database** field, enter the name of the Changepoint database.



- d) In the **Login ID** field, enter the SQL server account for the Changepoint database.
- e) In the **Password** field, enter the password.

#### Upgrading the scheduled jobs

Copy the contents of the Manual Upgrade\ScheduledJobs\ folder to your Changepoint ScheduledJobs folder.

#### Upgrading the website

Manual upgrade website files are not available.

#### **Completing the installation**

- 1. Reset IIS.
- Restart the Redis service in Windows Services.
- 3. Files that are cached on users' browsers are updated automatically. If users encounter issues, advise them to clear their browser history and try again.

#### **Caveats and notes**

- The installer is cumulative. You can install the package from CP 2021 GA.
- The release package installer is available in English only.
- After a release package is applied, it cannot be uninstalled regardless of whether it
  was installed using the InstallShield wizard or manually.
- If the error "!!! MSDTC on server 'server\_name' is unavailable." occurs during the release package installation or the manual database upgrade using SQLImport.exe, do the following:
- Start the "Distributed Transaction Coordinator" service on the server where the database upgrade is being performed.
- Repeat the manual database upgrade steps to complete the installation process.
- Changepoint Archiving feature Customers who have deployed the Changepoint Archive solution must ensure that their archived environment is upgraded to the same release version as their production site.

**Warning:** Failure to maintain the correct release version may result in the Archive scheduled job failing.
