

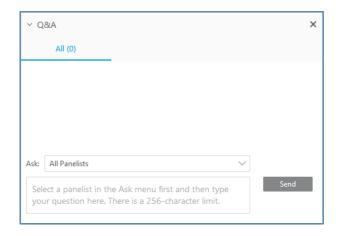

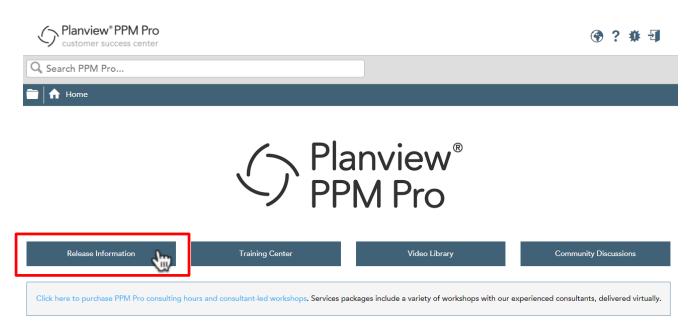

# Monthly Release Schedule

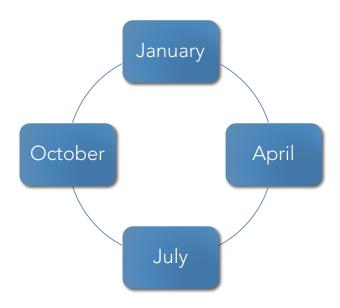
First Friday Release Notes Published

Second Friday Release deployed to sandbox environments

Third Friday • Release deployed to production environments



### Features move from Beta to GA once a quarter



- Between GA releases, Beta features are available in sandboxes
- Beta features can be enabled in production environments by request. Note that any issues you discover will be fixed as part of the normal development cycle.



# Get early access to features in your sandbox

- A sandbox is a snapshot of your production environment
- Beta functionality is enabled in sandboxes by default
- Don't have one? Contact your Account Manager (additional fee)

Note: Sandbox data cannot be refreshed between the second and third Fridays of the month

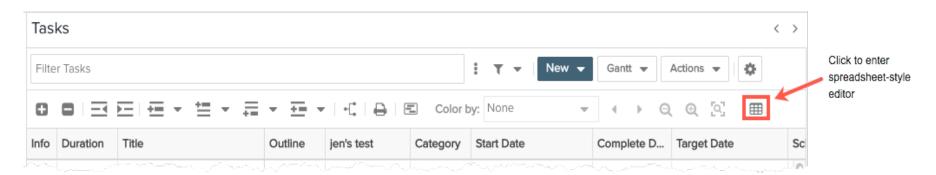
## Spreadsheet-Style Task Editor – Now GA

- Improved multi-user support with user icons
- Handles up to 1000 tasks
- Keyboard and editing interaction like a spreadsheet, including Undo/Redo
- Copy/paste to and from other spreadsheet tools, such as Excel and Google Sheets
- Basic validation and correction handling
- Reconciliation guidance



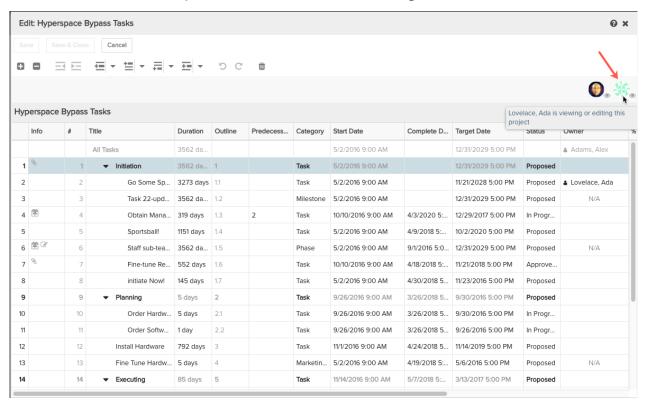
# Spreadsheet-Style Task Editor

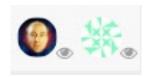
Toggle/editor available for users with Project > Edit > Tasks permission

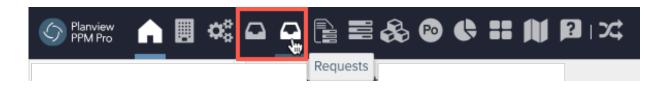






### Request Revamp – Review

- Existing requests renamed to "Legacy Requests"
- New Requests tab in top navigation upon opt-in
- Hover text "Requests"
- Can opt-in in production; already enabled in sandboxes





## Request Revamp – Rolling Beta

#### Current Beta Functionality

- New Requests UI for composing requests
- Configure request types using Self-Service Administration
- New graphical, status-based card view
- Associate requests with new and existing projects, tasks, and issues

- New Request Status field
- Ability to copy notes and attachments to associated entities
- Request categorybased permissions (in addition to All Requests permission)
- Basic Reporting
- Reporting on associations

- API currently works, but not revealed in UI
- Scoring
- Show on New
- Gates
- **Notifications**
- Single Approvers

#### **Future Releases**

- Multiple Approvers
- Advanced gate logic
- Data Import
- API reveal on Admin/Web Services section



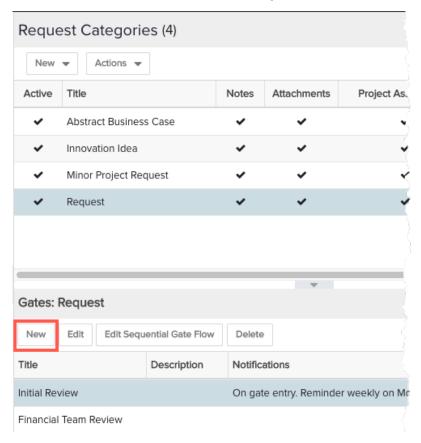

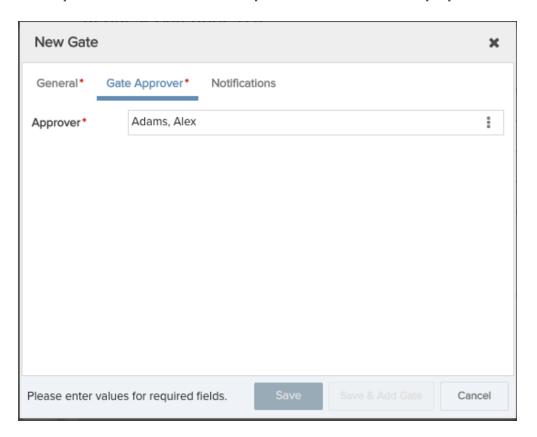

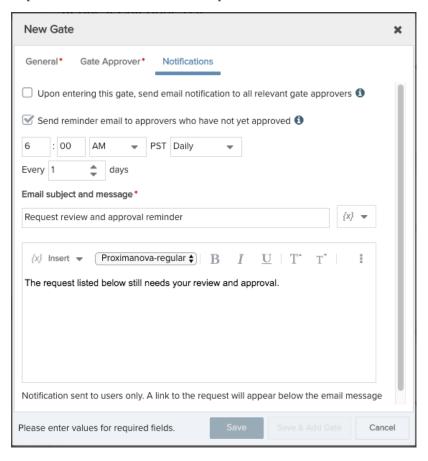


### Request Revamp – Gate Approver



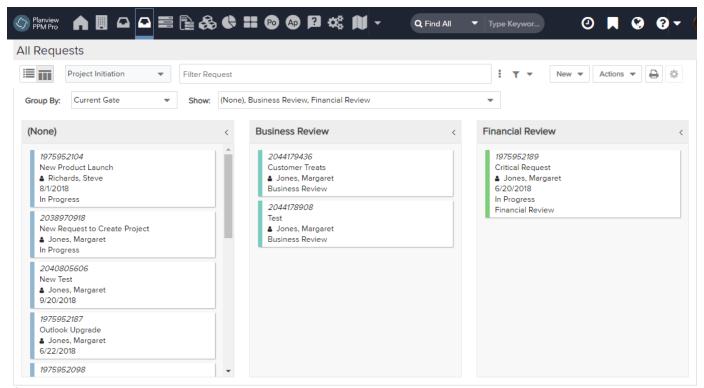

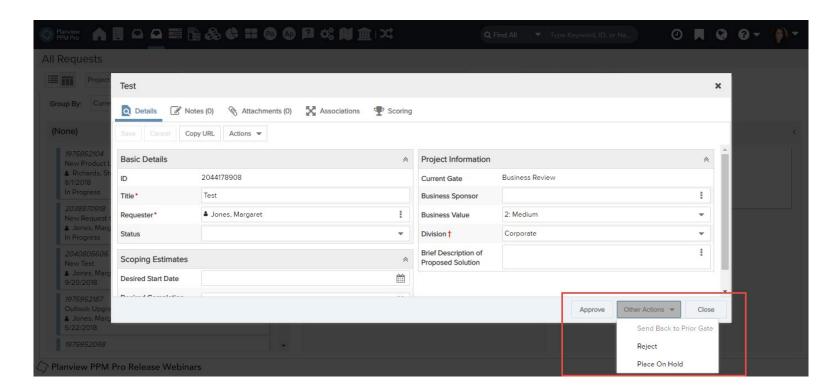
### Request Revamp – Card View with Gates

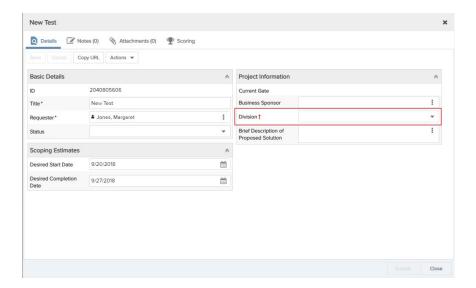

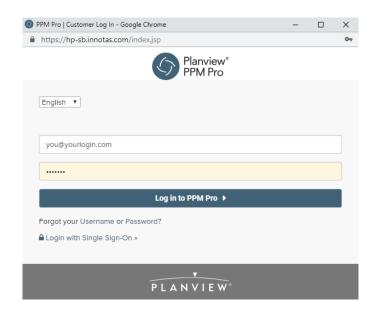




- Ability to disable the New buttons for:

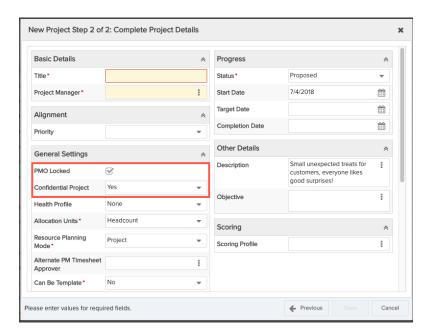


- When a session times out, you will be prompted to enter your login credentials in a new modal
- You will be returned to where you were when your session timed out, and in most cases any work in progress will be preserved





 When creating a project from a template, the PMO Locked and Confidential Project settings are now included in the copy.

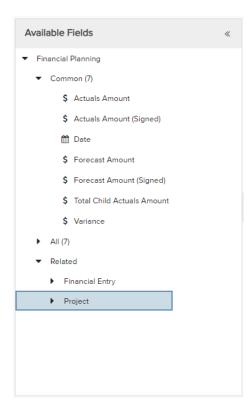




- Two new resource planning report sources:
  - Resource Planning by Role Estimates
  - Resource Planning for Role Estimates for a Selected Project
- Report on the task role estimated hours/cost (not the resource schedules scheduled hours/cost, which are handled by the Resource Planning by Resource Schedules report sources)
- Note that Resource Planning by Resource Schedules report sources now allow you to report on role estimates (as a related entity)



• The "Project" field has been added to the Common folder for Financial Entry and Financial Planning reports.



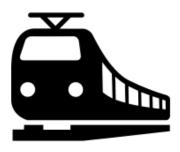


• The user type formerly known as "T&E User" has been renamed to "Time User". Time users can log time and view tasks and project logs that they own, as well as tasks they are scheduled to.
