



Monthly Release Schedule


First Friday Release Notes Published

Second Friday Release deployed to sandbox environments

Third Friday • Release deployed to production environments



Features move from Beta to GA once a quarter



- Between GA releases, Beta features are available in sandboxes
- Beta features can be enabled in production environments by request. Note that any issues you discover will be fixed as part of the normal development cycle.



Get early access to features in your sandbox


- A sandbox is a snapshot of your production environment
- Beta functionality is enabled in sandboxes by default
- Don't have one? Contact your Account Executive (additional fee)

Note: Sandbox data cannot be refreshed between the second and third Fridays of the month

Reports Revamp – Rolling Beta

Current Beta Functionality

- Usability enhancements
- New Reports grid with Group By
- Basic report topics and types, including new line, area, heat map, and spider charts
- New WYSIWYG report designer
- List report options changeable within preview
- Ability to include filters at initial runtime and/or while viewing the report

- Ability to set multiple scopes for the report
- Ability to report on indirectly-related data
- Date and number formats
- Hierarchical column sorting
- Gantt report type

Future Releases


- · List report:
 - Grouping and aggregations
 - · Hierarchies and merging
 - Multi-column format
- Report drilldown
- Reports with time series data, portfolio project relationships, staffing/resource planning, and historical data (Audit, KPI)

- · View references
- Export to PowerPoint
- Dashboards with WYSIWYG designer:
 - Reports and rich text/image content
 - Runtime and view filters
- Home and project Overview (dashboards)



Reports Revamp – Gantt Type

- Similar to Legacy Gantt, couple of capabilities still to add
- New List options, except no Wrapping
- New Scope and Filter options







Enhancement – Undo/Redo

Undo/Redo for all SSA entity Details panels/sections:

- project Details, Additional Details, Settings
- all tabbed Details, such as task and portfolio Details
- tabbed areas in Admin, such as User Details
- modals such as Bulk Editor and New Request


