Installing the patch manually

Note: This update has a dependency on General patch 19.00.119.000, 19.00.121.000 and 19.00.136.000, which must be installed before installing this update.

1. Stop the following services:
 - a) Changepoint Communication Dispatcher Service
 - b) Changepoint DataMapper Service
 - c) Changepoint Export Publishing Service
2. Uninstall the services using the Windows Control Panel:

Changepoint Export Publishing Service
3. Install the following services from the patch package:

Changepoint Export Publishing Service
4. For the Changepoint Export Publishing service
 - a) use the `LoginSettings.exe` utility to configure the database connection for it.
 - b) open the configuration files, and replace the hostname value with the FQDN of the machine running the RabbitMQ service, as follows:

<add key="MessageBroker.HostName" value="amqps://hostname"/>
```
5. Start the following services:
 - a) Changepoint Communication Dispatcher Service
 - b) Changepoint DataMapper Service

- c) Changepoint Export Publishing Service
6. Open SQL Management Studio and execute `1900139000.sql` against the Changepoint database.

Caveats and notes

If you have Integration Framework with resource location field mapping in transformation file, you must apply the Changepoint API January Release, and update the transformation file.
