# Upgrade instructions and additional information

- 1. On the Cognos App Tier server, launch IBM Cognos Configuration, and click the Stop button to stop the IBM Cognos service.
- Copy the ChangepointCAP.jar file from the patch folder Cognos\Analytics\webapps\p2pd\WEB-INF\lib to %programfiles%\ibm\cognos\analytics\webapps\p2pd\WEB-INF\lib folder.
- 3. Copy the files from patch folder of Cognos\Analytics\webcontent to **%programfiles%\ibm\cognos\analytics\webcontent** folder.
- 4. Start the IBM Cognos service and then exit IBM Cognos Configuration.
- 5. Advise users to sign out of Changepoint, and clear the browser cache.
- 6. Open SQL Server Management Studio with sufficient rights:
  - Execute 1900135000a.sql against the ContentStore database.
  - Execute 1900135000b.sql against the Changepoint database.



#### Caveats and notes

If an email delivery method is used for a report, the name of the user sending the
report is automatically added to the **Recipients** field. However, the name is not a
valid email address and will result in an undeliverable email. To correct this issue
you must remove the name from the **Recipients** and **Senders** fields, and then
select the correct name or enter a valid email address.
