

# Changepoint 2020 19.00.122.000 Salesforce.com Integration Toolkit Update Release Notes

#### **Enhancements**

Replace Microsoft Service Bus message broker with RabbitMQ for Salesforce.com integrations.

#### **Technical details**

See the "Message Broker Replacement Overview" section in the release notes for Integration Framework update 19.00.121.000.

#### Installing the update manually

**Note:** This update has a dependency on General patch **19.00.119.000** and Integration Framework update **19.00.121.000**, which must be installed before installing this update.

- 1. Stop the following services:
  - a) Changepoint Communication Dispatcher Service
  - b) Changepoint DataMapper Service
  - c) Changepoint Export Publishing Service
- 2. Stop the Changepoint website.
- 3. Create a backup copy of the content in the Enterprise\ExternalEndPoint folder.
- 4. Install the RabbitMQ Service and client when applicable, by following the instructions in the "Installing the RabbitMQ Service" section in the *Integration Framework Reference Guide*.
- 5. Copy the content from the ExternalEndPoint folder on the patch and paste the files into the Enterprise\ExternalEndPoint folder on your web server.
- 6. In the Enterprise\ExternalEndPoint\ folder, open the Web.config file and replace the hostname value with the FQDN of the RabbitMQ server, as follows:



```
<!-- Message Broker specific app settings for messaging connections -> <add key="MessageBroker.HostName" value="amqps://hostname"/>
```

- 7. Start the Changepoint website
- 8. Start the RabbitMQ Service.
- 9. Start the following Windows services:
  - a) Changepoint Communication Dispatcher Service
  - b) Changepoint DataMapper Service
  - c) Changepoint Export Publishing Service
- 10. Open SQL Management Studio and execute 1900122000.sql against the Changepoint database.
