Upgrade instructions and additional information

- 1. Create a backup copy of the configuration file for the Changepoint API.
- 2. Uninstall the previous version of the Changepoint API using Windows Control Panel.
- 3. Copy the contents of the API Setup folder to the location on the server where Changepoint API will be installed.
- 4. Run Setup.exe and follow the prompts to install the COM API and Web Services. For more information, see the *Changepoint API Installation Guide*.
- 5. Replace the backup copy of the configuration file for the Changepoint API.
- 6. Open SQL Server Management Studio with sufficient rights and execute 1801108000.sql against the Changepoint database.
