## Upgrade instructions and additional information

1. Using the instructions in the *Changepoint Installation Guide*, do the following:
  - a) Import the base data model (model.zip).
  - b) Add customized field labels and configurable fields to the data model.
2. Upgrade the database
  - a) Open SQL Management Studio with sufficient rights.
  - b) Execute 2000031000a.sql against the **ContentStore** database.
  - c) Execute 2000031000b.sql against the **Changepoint** database.

### Apply update on Cognos Analytics AppTier server:

1. Stop the IBM Cognos Service
2. Copy the ProfileLink.js file from AppTier folder in the package to the applicable folder on Cognos AppTier server.

The default folder path is :

C:\Program Files\ibm\cognos\analytics\webcontent\

3. Start the IBM Cognos Service.
4. Send an email to advise users to clear the browser cache.
5. For report creators, open each of their reports in Analytics Portal, and then follow the prompts to accept the changed package.
